

MINIMUM WAGE

The Minimum Wage rate per hour depends on your age and whether you're an apprentice - you must be at least school leaving age.

^{*}This rate is for apprentices aged 16 to 18 and those aged 19 or over who are in their first year. All other apprentices are entitled to the Minimum Wage for their age.
